- Entering **10th grade** a student must have a minimum of **6 credits**.
- Entering **11th grade** a student must have a minimum of **13 credits**.
- Entering **12th grade** a student must have a minimum of **20 credits**.

General Information

- Read Course Catalog, new one posted in December
- We require 2 years of Foreign Language
- We recommend 4 years of Math and Science before College
- AP classes can be taken Junior and Senior year. Honors classes and AP classes should be limited.
- Participation in one full season in interscholastic athletic competition will waive 1/2 credit of Physical Education.
- Public Speaking requirement is met through debate and forensics or enrollment in two (2) consecutive years of choir, band or drama.
