

Christian Stewardship Program: Possible Agencies

General Requirements

- Students will complete a minimum of 30 service hours at one social service organization each year.
- Unless otherwise approved, students will complete service with four different service organizations.
- Each year students will contact and gather information from their service organization in order to complete a Pre- Approval Form, along with a signature of their supervisor.
- Each year students will have their project pre-approved through the Theology/Faith Formation Department.
- Students will create a well-documented four-year CSP Portfolio by means of pre-approval forms, time logs, in- class reflections, and final paper culminating in a senior presentation, that will include pictures of their service.
- Yearly CSP presentations will be given by each student during the spring semester.
- CSP will be 10% of the student's second semester theology grade. The pre-approval form will be due first semester as a homework grade. If the pre-approval form is not turned in by the due date, a zero will be entered into the grade book. If the pre-approval form is still not turned in within 30 days, the student will be sent home until a pre-approval form is turned in.
- Students who serve in the summer must also have projects pre-approved and document their service.

Freshmen / Sophomores:

- It is highly encouraged for either Freshman or Sophomore year service to be completed within the students' parish.
- If both years of service are completed at the same organization, students must demonstrate a change in project or increase of responsibility.
- Yearly presentation is conducted through theology class. If the hours, paper and presentation are not completed, you will not be able to move on to the next grade level.
